Wine Region **Baden / Kaiserstuhl**

Tradition Grapes of old vine stocks are harvested from the best vineyard sites with a yield of 60 liter per hectare at maximum and mature for 6 months in big oak barrels.

Site Eichstetter Herrenbuck The unique terroir of Eichstetten brings up excellent wines from the Pinot family. A combination of volcanic soil with a loess layer on top and mild climate conditions on the Kaiserstuhl make this area a perfect spot for wine-growing. These natural conditions together with the maturation in big oak barrels create the most characterful wines.

Wine Description Bright ruby-red colour, pleasing wild berry and cherry aromas in the nose. Full-bodied and complex wine with well integrated tannin structure and decent oaky aromas.
